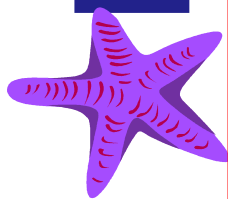




What we will be learning about: living things - plants and animals

Expressive Arts and Design

Explore rubbings, patterns, texture through printing and collage. Look at work by Matisse and Van Gogh.
Make models from junk modelling materials.
Investigate musical instruments and how they are played.
Learn about tempo and rhythm.

Personal, social and emotional Relationships

Exploring how they can hurt others' feelings and how others can hurt their feelings, developing strategies to deal with this.
Investigating fair and unfair situations.
Exploring feelings about being left and losing something we care about.

Fab finish: We will bring home a plant we have grown from seed

Communication, Language and Literacy

Books:
Jasper's Beanstalk, The Tree, Little Red riding Hood.
Reading and writing sentences.
Use phonic knowledge to read and spell.
Read and write common words correctly.

The big question: What does 'alive' mean?

Physical

Develop ball skills – throwing, catching, passing.
Begin to control size of letters and form all letters and numbers correctly.

Mathematical

Automatically recall number bonds for numbers 0-10
Doubling
Halving
Sharing
Verbal counting beyond 20 recognising the pattern of the number system
Length – cms
Positional language
Time – O'clock, half past
