How to help at home with writing

Hold a sentence book — practice keywords and common exception words — can they read and spell them?

Play snap with words they find difficult to spell.

Pen disco - play music and let them draw, colour etc.

Read, read, read!

Watch QR codes.

Fine motor activities — ripping newspaper, squeezing plasticine etc.

Talking in clear sentences, can they talk about their day? Can they give reasons for opinions (because)?
