

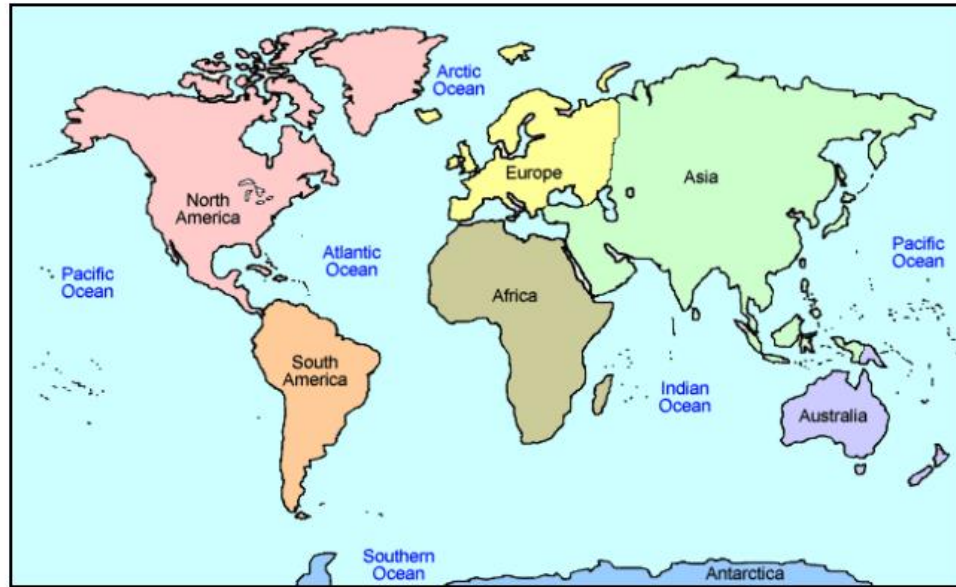


## Important People

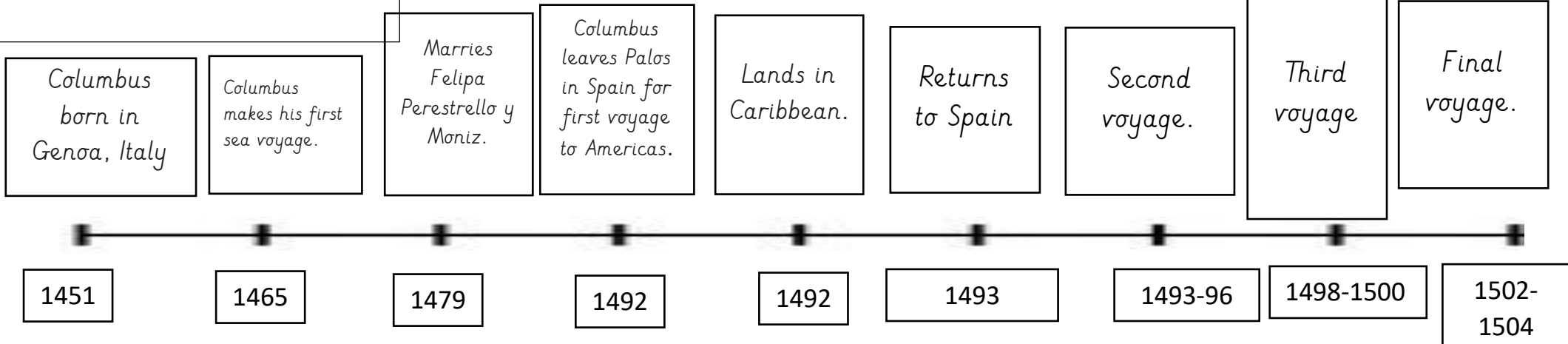
## Map of the Oceans and Continents.



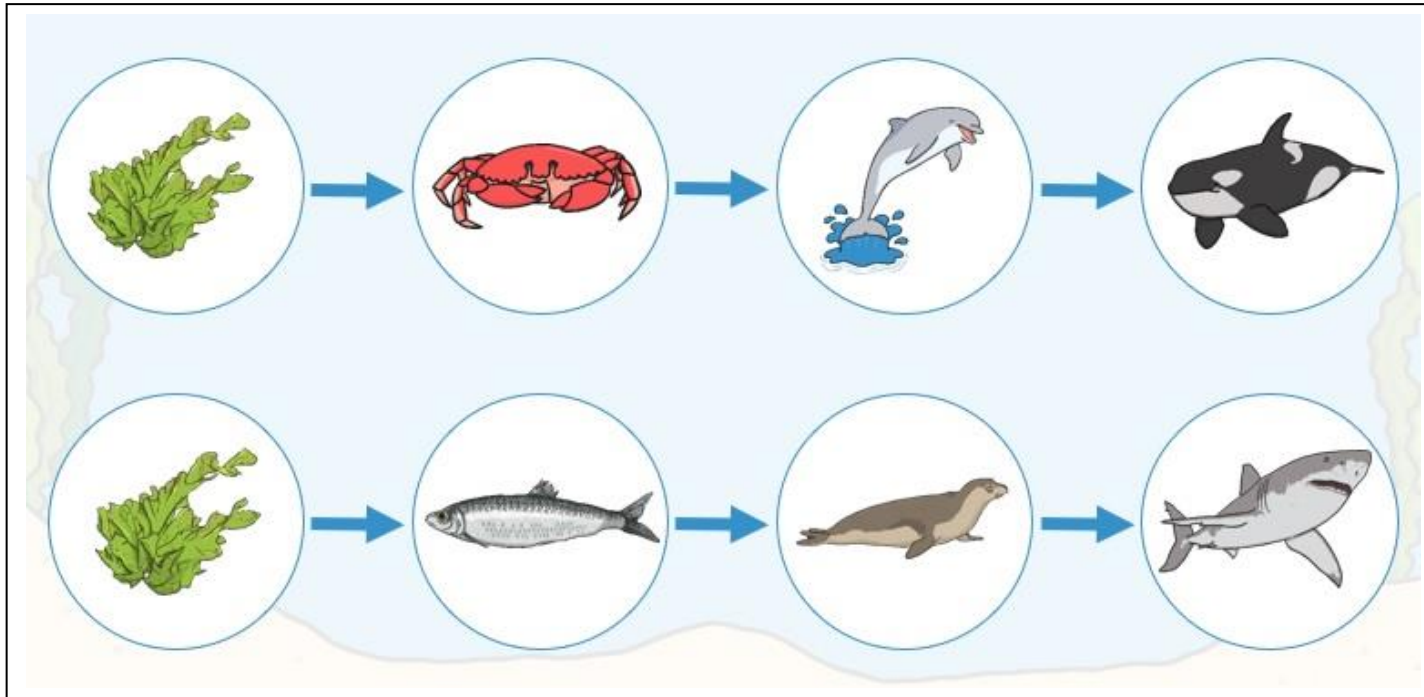
## The Pirates Next Door - Story

**equator** – The equator is an imaginary circle around Earth. It divides Earth into two equal parts: the Northern Hemisphere and the Southern Hemisphere.

**gills** – Gills are what fish, amphibians, and some other animals use to breathe in water.

**fins** – A fin is a thin, flat body part of a fish and certain other water animals which is used for swimming or balance.

**habitat** – a habitat is a home for an animal or plant.

**food chain** – a food chain is a sequence describing how different animals eat other other, showing the order in which living things depend on each other for food.

**voyage** – a long journey by air, land, sea, or outer space.

**Caribbean** – sits between the islands of the West Indies and the coasts of Central and South America
