



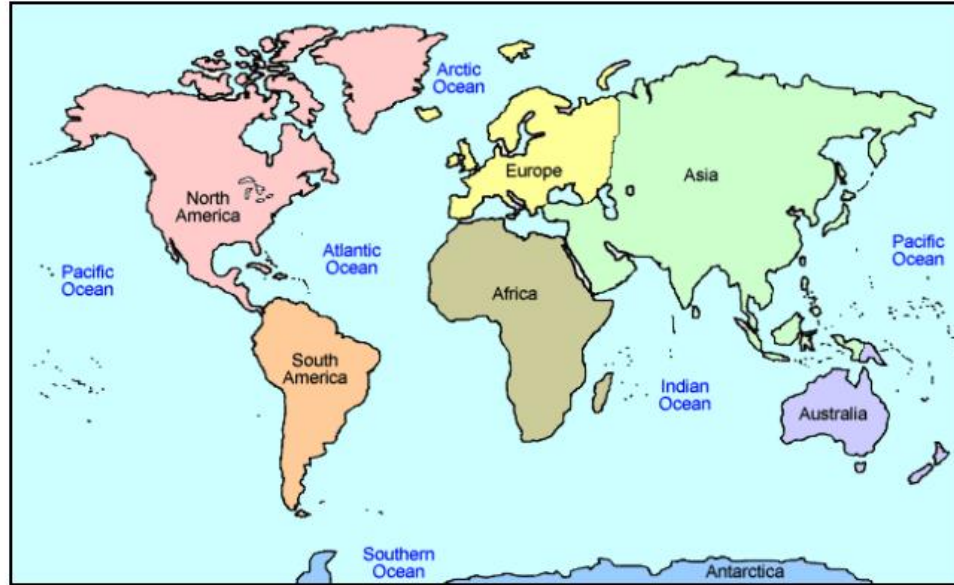
## Important People

At the age of just 25, Elizabeth II became queen of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. She came to the throne after the death of her father, King George VI, in 1952. In 2015 she became the longest-reigning British monarch. In 2022, she will celebrate her Platinum Jubilee, 70 years serving as our Queen. 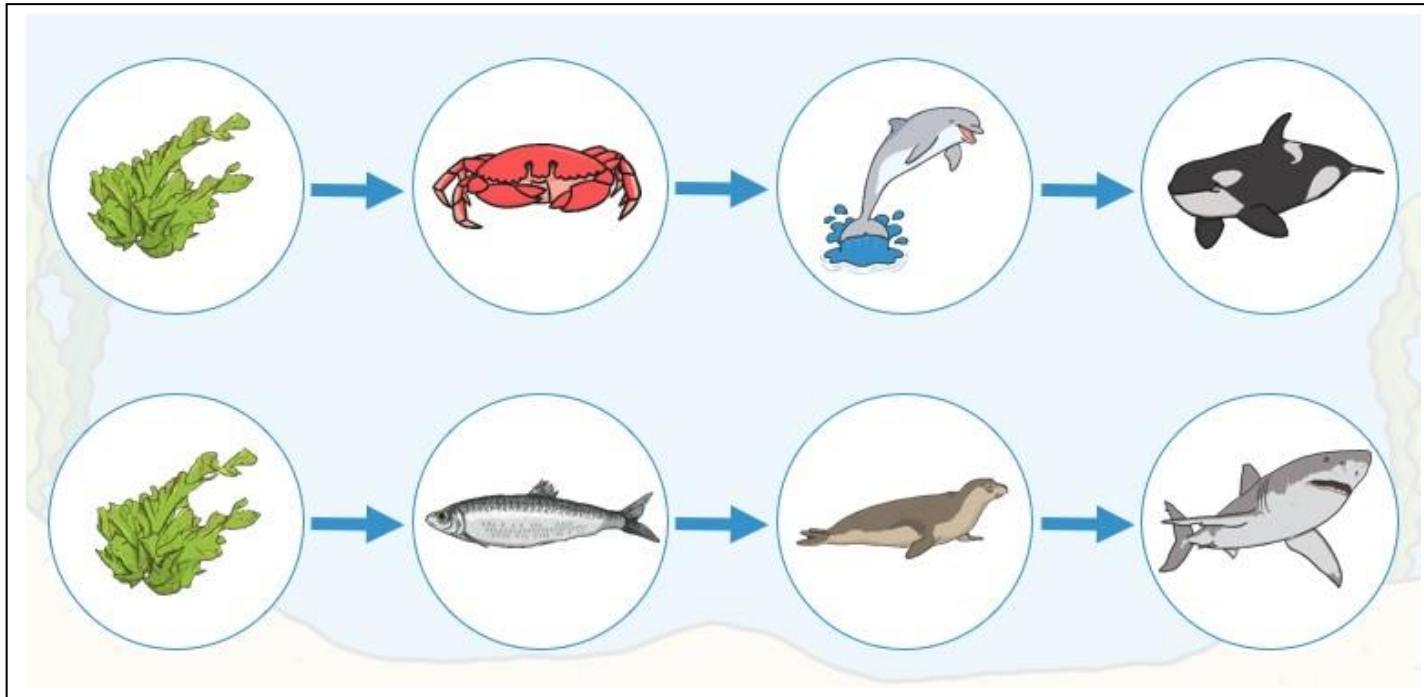

## Key Vocabulary

**continent** – A continent is a large solid area of land.

**ocean** – An ocean is a huge body of salt water.

**compass** – A compass is a tool for finding direction.

**equator** – The equator is an imaginary circle around Earth. It divides Earth into two equal parts: the Northern Hemisphere and the Southern Hemisphere.

**coronation** - A coronation is a ceremony that gives a monarch regal or royal power.

**monarch** - A person who reigns over a kingdom or empire.

**Golden Jubilee** – Celebrating the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary for an event or special occasion.

**gills** – Gills are what fish, amphibians, and some other animals use to breathe in water.

**fins** – A fin is a thin, flat body part of a fish and certain other water animals which is used for swimming or balance.

**habitat** – a habitat is a home for an animal or plant.

**food chain** – a food chain is a sequence describing how different animals eat other, showing the order in which living things depend on each other for food.
