Expressive Arts and Design

We will be creating artwork using loose parts that might be found on the beach. We will be making collages of our favourite kind of dream holiday. We will be making junk models of our homes and be thinking about the best ways of joining materials together.

Personal, social and emotional

We will be playing a range of turn taking games. We will be taking part in circle time activities where we must listen and respond appropriately. We will be thinking about manners and how we should use them appropriately.

Communication, Language and Literacy

We will be listening to stories from around the world and learning about different places and different cultures. The children will be encouraged to listen to and discuss longer stories. We will be joining in with lots of nursery rhymes and learning some new ones.

New Vocabulary: bus, train, aeroplane, tickets, passport, postcard, holiday, adventure, beach, sunshine, mountains, river, lake, sea, sand, shells, pebbles, forest, jungle, travel, explore

Our theme is 'Big Wide World'

Physical/Literacy

We will be continuing to work on our name writing (if ready). We will be making our own 'passports' for travel and will be writing postcards from our favourite places. We will be taking part in sports day and will be working on moving confidently in different ways and avoiding obstacles!

Understanding the World

We will be discussing different types of transport, where it might go and how it moves. We will be talking about holidays and where we would like to go and how we would get there? We will also be looking at baby photos to see how we have changed since we were tiny. We will see if we are able to identify each other as babies. .

Mathematical

we will be ordering numbers from 1-5 and beyond. We will be selling tickets for the aeroplanes/trains/buses etc in our role play and will counting out the correct number of tickets that are needed. We will be sorting shells and pebbles according to size and features.

- Encourage your child to be as independent as possible
