Expressive Arts and Design

We will have lots of fun working on process art and will be exploring lots of colour mixing. We will create some art linked to our topic stories. We will continue singing on a daily basis and will be learning some new songs.

Personal, social and emotional

We will be working with our friends to complete small tasks such as building houses for the pigs and making bridges for the gingerbread man so he can get across the river safely. We will be making sure all the children are aware of the behavioural expectations for the nursery and can follow the rules and routines.

Communication, Language and Literacy

We will enjoy listening to lots of different traditional tales, but our focus will be on The Three little Pigs, Goldilocks and The Gingerbread man. We will be acting out these stories in our role play area and will be following instructions to make porridge and of course gingerbread men.

Physical/Literacy

We will be building houses for the pigs. Who can make one that is the strongest? We will be writing lists for any building materials we may need. We will be continuing to mark make on a daily basis and will be using lots of different resources to do this.

Understanding the World

We will be looking closely at the weather and getting outside in all different weathers! We will be discussing our journeys to school and will be making our own maps to show the way. We will be discussing all the things we might see out of the car window or on our daily walks.

Mathematical

We will be focusing on numbers 4,5 and 6 for our number of the fortnight. We will be recognising the number, finding the amount and using our fingers to represent it. We will be making ABAB patterns with different objects and resources and we will be using lots of positional language. We will also be continuing to rote count to 10.
