What is the Phonics Screening Check?

- A word-reading test at the end of Year 1.
- Children read 40 words.



Phonics

Year 1 Phonics Quiz

All children in year 1 in England take the quiz to see how they're progressing with phonics.

This quiz is set by the Government and all children take the same quiz.

There are 40 words in the quiz which the children are required to read.

There are 20 real words, made up of one and two syllables, and 20 pseudo words (nonsense words – silly pseudo!)

The idea is that the children should be able to use their phonic knowledge to read both the real and nonsense words accurately.

It is expected that the children should be able to read at least 32/40 correctly.

The quiz will be done on a one to one basis with a familiar adult.

Story Green Words

For each word ask your child to read the separate sounds, e.g. 'b-u-s', 'p-oo-l' and then blend sounds together to make the word, e.g. 'bus', 'pool'. Sometimes one sound is represented by more than one letter, e.g. 'th', 'oo'. These are underlined.

Mama nest cluck hatch crack chick quack pond
quick as a flash bank

Ask your child to say the syllables and then read the whole word.

upset duck chick

Ask your child to read the root first and then the whole word with the suffix.

peck → pecked shock → shocked grub → grubs
 flap → flapped stretch → stretched crust → crusts
 hop → hopped grab → grabbed

Red Words

Red words don't sound like they look. Ask your child to read the words but if he or she gets stuck read the word to your child.

Speedy Green Words

Ask your child to practise reading the words across the rows, down the columns and in and out of order clearly and quickly.

Important note

Read stories to your children that are beyond the level they can read for themselves – every evening. They'll only want to become readers if they experience the joy of listening to a range of stories, non-fiction and poetry. Very soon, they will be able to read those books for themselves, as well as listen to them.

Vocabulary check

Tell your child the meaning of each word in the context of the story.

	definition:	sentence:
den	an animal's home under the ground	He sat in his den ...
trick	a sneaky thing to do	He sat in his den, thinking up a trick.
shed	a small, wooden building	Mama Hen slept in the shed.
scratched	marked the ground with their feet	The chicks scratched ... at the mud.
solid	very hard	"It is as solid as rock ..."



Questions to talk about

Read the questions aloud to your child and ask him or her to find the answers on the relevant pages. Do not ask your child to read the questions – the words are harder than he or she can read at the moment.

- p.9 What does Mama hen feel about egg 6, and why?
- p.10 Which two words describe chicks 1–5?
- p.11 Why is Mama hen so shocked when egg 6 hatches?
- p.12 How is the duckchick different to chicks 1–5?
- p.13 What do the other chicks do while the duckchick is in the pond?
- p.14 What do all the chicks say when they fall in the pond?
- p.15 What does the duckchick do to keep the chicks safe?

Questions to read and answer

Ask your child to read the questions and choose the correct answer.

1. What did Mama hen sit on?
Mama hen sat on a **bed / nest / log**.
2. How many eggs did Mama hen have?
Mama hen had **ten / six / seven** eggs.
3. What did Mama hen jump onto?
Mama hen jumped onto a **fox / log / dog**.
4. Who was watching the chicks?
A dog / man / fox was watching the chicks.
5. Who swam to help the chicks?
The **fox / dog / duckchick** swam to help the chicks.
