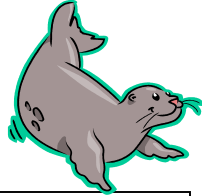




Key stage 1 Autumn 1



Literacy

We will read the book "Man on the moon". To help Bob, we will write a job advert to help him keep the moon clean. We will write instructions to help keep the moon clean. We will also read Beegu and think about Beegu's emotions throughout the text.

Science

We will be taking on Mission X – to train like an astronaut! We will be learning about gravity, exercise, healthy eating, and growing plants in space!

Maths

We are going to explore numbers through counting and place value. We will also solve problems involving money, addition, subtraction, length and height.

Topic hook / round up.

We are going to have an interactive space experience to hook our topic 'Space' inside a virtual dome. The children are going to learn about space, the first moon landing and what it takes to be an astronaut.

How can you help?

Can you research information about Neil Armstrong or space? What can you find out? Bring any research into class to share.

History.

We will be learning about the first moon landing and Neil Armstrong. We will compare his mission to the mission that Tim Peake took.
